

Lamb Weston Privacy Policy

Effective Date: September 28, 2017

Lamb Weston Holdings, Inc., its affiliates and subsidiaries (“Lamb Weston” or “we”) recognizes that those who visit our websites are concerned about how personal information they provide online is maintained and used by Lamb Weston. To address these concerns, this policy describes our online information practices and the choices that you can make about the collection and use of your information.

This Privacy Policy applies to lambweston.ca, and Lamb Weston’s websites, services, applications and products that collect data and display these terms (collectively, our “sites”).

We collect information from and about you.

Information you submit. We collect the information you submit to us. This might include our social media pages on third party websites.

Other information. If you use our website, we may collect information about the browser you’re using. We may also collect your IP address and/or device identifier. We might look at what site you came from, or what site you visit when you leave us, what links you click on, or what pages you view.

We collect information in different ways.

We collect information directly from you. For example, if you submit your information to us.

We collect information from you passively. We use analytics tools like browser cookies and web beacons. For example, we collect details of the site where the visitor has come from and the total number of times a visitor has been to our website.

We get information about you from third parties. For example, our business partners may give us information about you, and social media platforms may also give us information about you, as legally permitted. We may also get information from other sources, such as public databases, data aggregators or other commercially available sources where legally permitted.

We use information as disclosed and described here.

We use information to respond to your requests or questions. For example, we might use your information to respond to your customer feedback.

We use information to improve our Site, products and services. We may use your information to make our website and products better.

We use information for security purposes. We may use information to protect our company, our customers, and our websites. We also use information to protect our websites and platforms.

We use information to communicate with you about your account or our relationship. We may contact you about your account or feedback. We might also contact you about this Policy or our website Terms and Conditions.

We use information as otherwise permitted by law or as we may notify you.

We may share information with third parties.

We will share information within the Lamb Weston family of companies. This includes future subsidiaries or affiliates.

We will share information with third parties who perform services on our behalf. For example, we share information with vendors who administer our website.

We will share information if we think we have to in order to comply with the law or to protect ourselves. For example, we will share information to respond to a court order or subpoena. We may share it if a government agency or investigatory body requests. We might share information when we are investigating potential fraud.

We may share information with a prospective buyer or any successor to all or part of our business. For example, if part of our business will be sold we may give our customer list as part of that transaction.

We may share information for other reasons we may describe to you.

You have certain choices about sharing and marketing practices.

You can opt out of receiving our marketing emails. To stop receiving our promotional emails, follow the instructions in any promotional message you get from us. Even if you opt out of getting marketing messages, we will still send you messages about your questions or necessary information about your account.

You can control cookies and tracking tools. Your browser may give you the ability to control cookies or other tracking tools. How you do so depends on the type of tool. Certain browsers can be set to reject browser cookies.

Our Do Not Track Policy: Some browsers have “do not track” features that allow you to tell a Site not to track you. These features are not all uniform. We do not currently respond to those signals. If you block cookies, certain features on our Site may not work. If you block or reject cookies, not all of the tracking described here will stop.

Certain options you select are browser and device specific.

These sites and children.

Our sites are generally meant for adults. We do not knowingly collect any personal information from children under 13 on our sites without permission from a parent or guardian. If you are a parent or legal guardian and think your child under 13 has given us information, you can email us at www.lambweston.com/contact-us.

We use standard security measures.

The Internet is not 100% secure. We cannot promise that your use of our sites will be completely safe. We encourage you to use caution when using the Internet. This includes not sharing your passwords.

We keep personal information as long as it is necessary or relevant for the practices described in this Policy. We also keep information as otherwise required by law.

We store information in the United States.

If you live outside of the United States, you understand and agree that we may transfer your information to the United States. This site is subject to U.S. laws, which may not afford the same level of protection as those in your country. Personal information stored and processed in the United States may be accessible to law enforcement and national security authorities of the United States.

We may link to other sites we don't control.

If you click on a link to a third party site, you will be taken to websites we do not control. This includes social media sites. This policy does not apply to the privacy practices of these websites.

Read the privacy policy of other third parties carefully. We are not responsible for these third party practices.
